

## Questions Reconfiguration

It would seem that the Woodbury superintendent and Board of Education have moved much too quickly to reconfigure the Region 14 school system.

Dr. Cronin had been in the district barely two months before sending his reconfiguration plan to the board. The board voted unanimously to approve the changes in 12 days.

That's a little like the "fox guarding the hen house." Had the board voted against Dr. Cronin, it would look like they were voting against the man they just hired.

It seems through the Board of Education meetings and other forums that the plan has not been fully thought out and questions still remain, yet the board is forging ahead with its seemingly untested and underdeveloped plan.
